

HIM 104.02 Health Data Classification – ICD-10-CA/CCI

This self-directed program provides the standard education in ICD-10- CA and CCI coding systems. It incorporates the application of coding theory to coding exercises with multiple assignments and sectional and final exams.

- Taking this course is NOT the equivalent of completing a Health Information Management Program. This is a standalone Classifications course intended for:
 - Individuals seeking Canadian HIM certification who were advised by CHIMA that a Classifications course was required to be completed; or
 - Certified HIM professionals who want to update/refresh their knowledge of the ICD-10-CA and CCI classifications, and the associated CIHI Coding Standards; or
 - HIM students wanting to complete the Classifications course separately as part of an overall HIM program.
